City of San Diego Storm Water Program Rose Creek Watershed Opportunities Project Report for January 1, 2006 – March 31, 2006 (Submitted on March 28, 2006)

Project Status

During the reporting period of January 1, 2005 through March 31, 2005, investigations were performed regarding exceedances of field screening trigger levels and analytical result standards. The attached Excel spreadsheet tilted Rose Creek Follow-ups (Attachment 1) provides an overview of the 9 exceedances over the field screening trigger levels or the analytical standards. Additionally, eight Field Monitoring Data Sheets (Attachment 2) are attached documenting the investigations of these 9 exceedances. Station 105 had two exceedances that were investigated at the same time. The investigations revealed that 8 initial exceedances were not found during the follow-ups. Dry Weather Monitoring Station 58 originally exceeded for bacteria the investigation found that fecal coliform and enterococcus levels had dropped. Fecal coliform levels remained slightly elevated; however, the ratio between total and fecal coliform levels was not indicative of sewage.

This is the final report because all Dry Weather Monitoring investigations for 2005 have been completed and reported.
